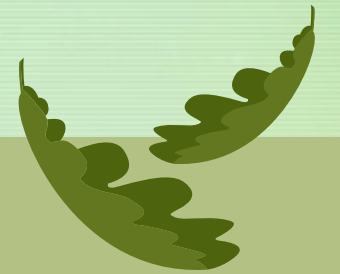

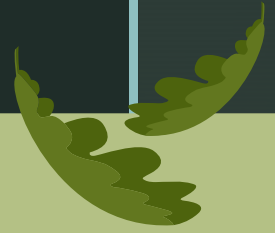

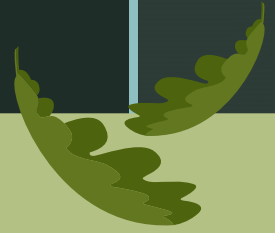

Access Audit

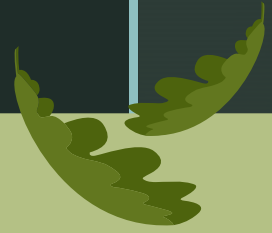
My assumptions

- Nearest toilets
- Description of car park and access
- Description of site paths - (1 in 5), surface, width etc
- Infrastructure – seating, gates etc
- What you can see
- What you can hear
- What you can smell
- What you can touch

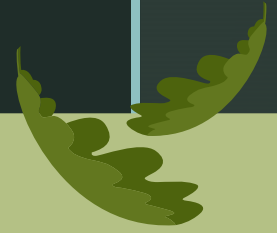
How to get there:

By Car

Birchmore Pond is on Birchmore Lane which is accessed off Blackwater Hollow. Follow the signs for 'Naturezones'. The site is on the corner where the lane forks to the left.

By Public transport

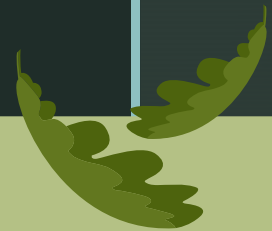
Blackwater Hollow Bus Stops (Route3). The pavement is flat and on the east side of Blackwater Hollow, Birchmore Lane is also the east side. It is 0.4 mile reasonably flat walk to the pond. The site is on the corner where the lane forks to the left.
